

What is the Collett's Corner car-share programme?

The residents of Collett's Corner will have access to five cars which will be shared between them. The cars will be provided by an established car-sharing company and will be available exclusively for residents to book through an online booking platform. The cars will live in the building's five underground car parks.

Why do we have it?

- To better use resources through sharing things we all use
- To work together to reduce our carbon emissions
- To lead local change and be early first adopters
- To live locally
- To save money
- To reduce demands for parking spaces

Who is the car-share provider?

There are two car sharing programmes, [Zilch](#), the sole provider of electric share-cars in Christchurch and [Cityhop](#), who are launching into Christchurch in 2021. By the time residents move in, we will have a car-share provider in place and they can provide more details about how their car-share offering works.

How will it work?

This is how we envision the car-share programme to work:

1. **Cars in place:** in the underground car parks
2. **Book online:** book the car you need for the time you want
3. **Scan your card:** each resident will have an access card which unlocks each of the share-cars by tapping it on the car's card reader
4. **Go driving**
5. **Return it:** to the designated car park
6. **Lock it:** by scanning your access card
7. **Ready for the next resident to use**

But what if...?

1. **Will the cars be free as part of buying an apartment, or will there be a cost to book and drive the car?**

The cars are not free, the car-share provider will charge you to use the cars.

2. **What if the five cars are being used?**

People will need to book for another time to use the car. If the ap has the capability you may be able to see who has the cars out and ask them if you could swap times if your trip is urgent or car pool.

3. **How long of a block can you book the car for - roadtrips, could someone selfishly book one of the cars for the entire year?**

People will need to pay for the time they book the cars, the cost of booking the car for a year would be prohibitive. People can use the cars for road trips but they will need to be aware of the range the electric cars can go and charge it.
